

Impact of Primary PE Money – 2014/2015 - £8190.00 (this is the money received during the Academic year, split across 2 financial years)

The school continues to make very good use of the soft play equipment purchased in the previous academic year. This equipment has been very successful at promoting physical education within our primary department. As in 2013/2014, many clubs and holiday clubs have also been put on with the focus around PE and outdoor play. The soft play equipment formed a core part of this offering.



2 members of staff have attended a Dance and Movement course to help deliver a varied and exciting Primary PE curriculum. Dance and Movement is important to our pupils as it helps promote:

- gross motor skills
- balance
- co-ordination
- flexibility
- strength

A Primary PE iPad has also been purchased to better allow the PE team to assessment and monitor progress being made by Primary pupils.

The majority of the funding this year has been used to improve storage of PE equipment so that all primary classes have easy and quick access to the equipment purchased to support said pupils. A lean-to storage extension was constructed and installed during Spring term 2015, costing £ 7614.20. This permanent additional to the school will provide a sustainable storage option for many years to come.

The remainder of the money has been used to support the purchase of additional resources to support our Primary aged pupils with multi-sensory impairments. Additional resources to support said group of pupils will be a focus of our work during the 2015/2016 academic year.
