<b>Strand and Profile</b>	<b>Profiles in Class</b>	<b>Ideas for Home</b>
<b>Communication and Literacy</b>	<p>Students will be working on their individual communication targets. Working towards their individualised EHCP/PLG targets.</p> <p>Students will be exploring the story "Summer Is" which is part of our Talk 4 Writing curriculum. They will be taking part in the immersion stage of this story.</p> <p>Students will attend the library for 1:1 reading sessions.</p>	<p>Explore communication/ encourage gesture and body language as communication.</p> <p>Read stories with a summer focus and theme, and books about going on holiday and to the beach. Take a trip to the beach.</p> <p>Read with your child. Explore tactile books, sound books.</p>
<b>Mathematics and Problem Solving</b>	<p>Students will be following a maths schema to encourage them to take part in problem solving activities and encourage use of fine motor skills.</p>	<p>Encourage your child to move and transport toys, encourage your child to alternate movement when playing; follow their eye movements and interests. Group toys and try ordering and sequencing.</p>
<b>Personal Development</b>	<p>Exploration of sensory trays linked to individual interests.</p>	<p>Encourage your child to play with sensory items of their choice.</p>
<b>Physical Development</b>	<p>They will be having regular visits to the Sensory Enrichment Room and ball pool.</p> <p>They also will take part in morning sensory circuits and attending the reef for swimming.</p>	<p>Try some body movement circuits at home or at the park. Encourage climbing, rolling, crawling, jumping.</p> <p>Go swimming with family and friends. Explore water play.</p>
<b>Understanding the World</b>	<p>Using our senses during cooking, and cooking to theme.</p> <p>We will be visiting the sensory room. Looking at reaction during sensory stimuli.</p>	<p>Try some cooking at home and explore using your senses. Explore summer recipes.</p> <p>Try relaxation sessions, with lights down low and some sensory lights.</p>
<b>Expression and Creativity</b>	<p>We will be creating art and crafts with a theme. This half term we will be linking art to our topic of Summer.</p>	<p>Encourage your child to explore different textiles and create different pictures using different textiles. Create drawings, paintings with a beach and seaside theme.</p>
<b>Personalised Learning</b>	<p>Students will follow their own Targets linked to their individual needs/EHCP outcomes.</p>	<p>Try to incorporate your child's PLGs in to daily life.</p>

This half term we will be going to The Reef, for swimming sessions.
