Subject	Profiles	Ideas for home
<p style="text-align: center;">Maths Addition/ Subtraction/ multiplication</p>	<p>In Summer 2, pupils will be following our White Rose-aligned pathway so that all pupils access the same topic through careful differentiation. There will be a strong emphasis on practical maths, reasoning, and applying number skills to real-life problems.</p>	<p>Pupils can practise their mathematical skills in their everyday lives. They can find numbers in their environments and try to link the different mathematical operations to different aspects of their lives e.g. weighing when cooking. They can begin to use addition and subtraction skills when going to the shops.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">English</p>	<p>This half term, pupils will explore settings through the book 'The Promise' by Nicola Davies. They will learn how authors build tension by describing the different settings in the book and they will be using the Talk 4 Writing scheme to help them to develop their own descriptions of new settings.</p>	<p>Talk with your children about the story . The story will develop as we go through the term so keep discussing what has happened each week and discuss the different vocabulary they have learnt.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Preparing for Adult Life (PfAL)</p>	<p>The pupils will be learning a variety of skill-based lessons on how to prepare for adult life. We will be using Panjango which is a set of lessons that focus on how to progress in careers. We will be focussing on the different skills such as problem solving. We will be looking at how we use money in our money skills lesson.</p>	<p>It is important that the children share the different skills they have learnt and transfer these into their everyday lives at home</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Art/DT (Creative)</p>	<p>Pupils will have the opportunity to choose and explore a range of Art, DT and creative options throughout the Summer Term.</p>	<p>Encourage your child to talk about what they have created each week. Check out EFL (Evidence for Learning) to see examples of what they have created.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">TITAN</p>	<p>We will be continuing with our TITAN training where we focus on being safe in our communities and travel on buses.</p>	<p>Pupils can look around their environments when they are out and about to help them develop their understanding of different road signs and how these can keep them safe.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Personal Development</p>	<p>We will be focussing on our bodies and the changes that happen during puberty.</p>	<p>Encourage your child to talk about these lessons and to understand the implications these situations can have on themselves and others.</p>
