Communication and Literacy	<p>This half term we are looking at a new story called 'The Promise.'</p> <p>We will begin by immersing ourselves in the book, focussing on our understanding of the plot and key themes.</p> <p>We will consider characters and settings before writing our own version of the story.</p> <p>Beech Class will try to edit improve their work.</p> <p>We will also continue our weekly 1:1 reading and regular phonics/spelling sessions.</p>	<p>Reading the book and reading other books by the author.</p> <p>Discussing the order of events in the book, the theme and the characters</p> <p>Segmenting and blending with Rhino Readers.</p> <p>Summarising and predicting with any text you read.</p> <p>It also helps to relate events in stories to the children's own lives.</p> <p>Visiting the library and enjoying chapter books together.</p>
Mathematics and Problem Solving	<p>Maths is learning about Time.</p> <p>We will use small 'show me' clocks so the children can practise making times by moving hands on clock faces.</p> <p>We will choose resources from the White Rose Maths scheme.</p> <p>In Computing we are continuing to present information on PowerPoint.</p> <p>We will be focussing on including images, video and sound as well as looking at transitions between slides.</p> <p>We will consider how PPTs can be most effective in conveying information.</p>	<p>Asking your pupil the time at home using analogue and digital clocks</p> <p>Telling the time songs on YouTube.</p> <p>Using timetables like those for public transport.</p> <p>How long until...?</p> <p>Experiment with PowerPoint at home, creating slides on a topic of interest.</p>
Personal Development	<p>PSHE is about the physical and emotional changes of puberty as well as age appropriate learning about relationships and reproduction.</p> <p>A letter will follow detailing this.</p>	<p>Discussing with your child if there are any concerns/worries they have about the content discussed.</p>
Physical Development	<p>In PE we will continue covering Athletics.</p> <p>We will be getting outside as much as possible to run and throw.</p> <p>We also have regular yoga sessions for wellbeing.</p>	<p>Going out for a jog.</p> <p>Watching Athletics events on TV.</p> <p>Joe Wicks routines on YouTube.</p> <p>Yoga videos on YouTube.</p>
Understanding the World	<p>History is looking at how Sheringham has developed as a tourist destination.</p> <p>We will be comparing seaside holidays then and now.</p> <p>Science is building on last half term's topic of magnetism and begin to consider Electricity.</p> <p>We will be making circuits and drawing the diagrams.</p> <p>Again the focus will be on working scientifically; planning and carrying out a fair test.</p>	<p>Internet and non-fiction book research.</p> <p>Free Twinkl activities.</p> <p>Online interactive resources, videos and songs.</p>
Expression and Creativity	<p>Art - We will be looking at 3 famous painters... Picasso, Van Gogh and Klee.</p> <p>We will be discussing their art works before attempting to recreate them.</p> <p>DT-Tracey is looking at personalisation of products including clothes.</p>	<p>Looking at artworks online.</p> <p>Online gallery tours.</p> <p>Simple craft activities from TV shows, activity books working on fine motor and assembly.</p> <p>Looking at products at home that may carry the children's names.</p>
