<b>Communication and Literacy</b>	<p>In our <b>English</b> lessons, we will be reading the Oliver Jeffers book 'The Way Back Home. We will be following our Talk 4 Writing scheme beginning with our immersion into the book, story and characters. We will explore the text, setting and message of the story. We will continue our learning of the 5 sentence story before mapping it out. We will then innovate aspects of the story and create our own story. We will continue with our weekly <b>Library</b> sessions where we can read for pleasure and enjoyment while working on our reading skills. We will also complete <b>1:1 Reading</b> each week.</p>	<p>Read your book from the Library at home with your family before bringing it back to school. Can you visit a Library in your local area too?</p> <p>Please bring your Twinkl reading book and Library book in each week to be changed.</p>
<b>Mathematics and Problem Solving</b>	<p>In our <b>Maths</b> lessons, we will be continuing to learn about Measurement. We will begin the half term learning about mass and weight. We will measure objects around us using standard and non-standard units of measure. We will link this with our weekly cooking too, exploring units of measure such as grams. We will enjoy using different weighing/balance scales. After this, we will learn about capacity and volume.</p> <p>In <b>Computing</b>, we will start the term off with a lesson on e-safety and how to remain safe online. Our topic this half term is project work. We will each choose a topic and create a presentation of photos, facts and videos. We will prepare this each week and then present it to the class.</p>	<p>Can you measure some objects at home? Can you complete some cooking activities?</p> <p>Remember to use your safety knowledge when on devices at home. Never communicate with anyone you do not know online. Always monitor your child's devices and communication online.</p>
<b>Personal Development</b>	<p>In our <b>PSHE</b> lessons, we will be learning about Body Awareness. We are aware this can be a sensitive and challenging topic for some learners so we will do this sensitively and appropriately for each pupil. Pupils will learn about the human life cycle and learn about the stage of life that they are going through/about to go through: puberty. Pupils will learn the scientific names of body parts. Pupils will work in small groups to complete activities and discussion led tasks.</p>	<p>Please feel free to communicate freely if there are any elements of PSHE that we can support your child with in school and at home which aims to ensure knowledge, skills and understanding to lead confident, healthy and independent lives.</p>
<b>Physical Development</b>	<p>In our <b>P.E.</b> lessons, we will be working on athletics. We will complete some athletic activities such as running, javelin, long jump... Pupils will complete a range of obstacle courses and activities to develop their athletic skills.</p>	<p>As it is getting lighter and brighter outside, can you play some football or ball games outside?</p>
<b>Understanding the World</b>	<p>Our humanities lesson this half term will be <b>History</b>. We will be learning all about The Tudors. Tracey will teach this.</p> <p>We will also have a themed day of <b>MFL</b> where we will be learning about France! We will find France on a map, learn about their culture, life, food, language and lots more!</p> <p>We will also have an <b>R.E.</b> day all about Judaism.</p>	<p>See if you can research your own fact about France ready for our lessons!</p>

<p><b>Community visits</b></p>	<p>Every Thursday we will be going to local supermarkets. Please provide your child with £1 to buy a snack while we are out.</p>	
<p><b>Expression and Creativity</b></p>	<p>Our topic in <b>Art</b> this half term is colour, shape and texture. We will be focusing on Architecture. Our artist this half term is: Sir Terry Farrell. We will explore the buildings he made before designing and making our own treasure island.</p> <p>In <b>Music</b>, we will be exploring musical instruments from our music cupboard. Pupils will learn how to play instruments and how to compose some music.</p> <p>We will also complete weekly <b>Cooking</b> lessons every Thursday.</p>	<p>What music do you like to listen to?
