This half term Chestnuts have worked hard on addition and subtraction in maths as well as looking at part whole models and number bonds to 10. In English we have looked at poems, we explored rhyming words, writing our own list poems based different foods and used the book Oliver's Milkshake as a stimulus for writing. Art was filled with using clay and using a range of techniques to create different pots and tiles. Throughout geography we discussed where we live and what places and points of interest were around Sheringham, Norfolk and the UK, We took this further and though about what was man made and what was natural. Science involved adaptations and how humans and animals are suited to their environment. We also explored teeth and how they are important and do different jobs. Finally, towards the end of term we have done lots of Christmas based activities such as visiting Woodfield's winter wonderland, having a visit from Santa, Making Christmas cards and decorations and baking gingerbread.

If you have not already got a login for Numbots and would like one, please let your child's teacher know.


